- ▶ The Asian Studies Center at Michigan State University awards graduate and undergraduate fellowships under the Foreign Language and Area Studies (FLAS) Fellowship program of the U.S. Department of Education.
- ▶ The FLAS Fellowship program is designed to meet critical needs for specialists in American education, government, and other services of a public and/or professional nature.
- ▶ This application announcement pertains to students who are enrolled in a program that combines Asian language study and international or area studies.
- ▶ Must be a U.S. Citizen, national of the U.S., or permanent resident to apply.

FLAS Academic Year (AY)

- **Graduate Students:** For Asian language and Asia area studies, fellowships offer tuition payments of up to \$18,000 per academic year, plus a monthly stipend each semester the award is held up to a total of \$15,000.*
- **Undergraduate Students:** For Asian language and Asia area studies, fellowships offer tuition payments of up to \$10,000 per academic year, plus a monthly stipend each semester the award is held up to a total of \$5,000.*

FLAS Summer Intensive Foreign language Study

Summer fellowships offer up to \$7,500 for intensive Asian language study abroad, or in the U.S., for graduate and undergraduate students. The tuition portion covers up to \$5000; the stipend portion covers up to \$2,500. Applicants must be at the intermediate or higher level of language study with evidence of a minimum of 12 credits in the proposed Asian language. Funds are available for Summer 2018.

*Funds for AY 2018-2019 fellowship awards will be contingent on receipt of grant funding by the MSU Asian Studies Center from the U.S. Department of Education. This does not apply to Summer 2018 awards.
